The SEED Center of Atlanta is a non-profit charitable organization dedicated solely to providing the coordination of services, education, and research to patients and their families with an eosinophilic disease.

The SEED Center of Atlanta’s primary goals are to provide services to patients in the Southeast with eosinophilic disorders and their families by:

- (1) Providing a collaborative multidisciplinary patient-centered approach.
- (2) Coordinating care services – patients with an eosinophilic disease require a variety of medical specialists to effectively manage this disease. We provide services to coordinate the care of these various medical specialists for you or your family member;
- (3) Providing patient and family support services through education for patients and their families and coordination of the services of healthcare professionals including but not limited to, gastroenterologists, allergists, psychiatrists, nutritionists, social workers, and school advocates;
- (4) Providing services for the transition to adult care; and
- (5) Conducting research to further understand this disease.

The SEED Center of Atlanta is governed by a board of directors comprised of volunteers from the community. Additionally, the services provided by The SEED Center of Atlanta are made possible through the charitable work and services provided by several physicians in the community that serve as medical directors for The SEED Center of Atlanta. Other than as provided for in separate agreements and in compliance with all applicable laws, neither the members of the board of directors nor the medical directors of The SEED Center of Atlanta derive any financial benefit from the services provided by The SEED Center of Atlanta to the patients The SEED Center of Atlanta serves.
